



What is the Entrance Assessment (Accuplacer)?

Accuplacer is an intuitive computerized diagnostic assessment system, which provides information about your level of skill and accomplishment in reading comprehension, and math. During the assessment, if your response to the first question is correct, the software will select a more difficult question next. If your response to the first question is incorrect, the software will then select a less difficult question. Once you have answered a series of 17 to 20 questions, the software determines your score, or benchmark.

If you have reached the benchmarks for apprenticeship, and if all other admission requirements have been met, you will be notified that you qualify to move forward in your apprenticeship.

If any of your results are below the required benchmarks, you will receive a letter indicating further work is required. The SATCC will require that you work with the online software program, MyFoundationsLab. MyFoundationsLab equips students with the skills and knowledge they need to thrive in apprenticeship technical training. MyFoundations Lab can be completed at your own pace, up to a maximum 6 months. A subsequent Accuplacer assessment will be required, after completion of MyFoundations Lab, to ensure the skills and knowledge have been obtained through your personalized learning path.
